Dogs on Site Policy

We love dogs at Worcester RFC, but we love our players more. Player and staff safety and welfare is our top priority. Dogs are allowed on site as long as owners act responsibly and follow the rules below

- Dogs must be kept on a lead, supervised and under control at all times.
- Do not use telescopic lead. This can cause a trip hazard, and you may not be aware of what your dog is doing several metres away from you!
- Dogs must never be taken onto the playing surfaces or training areas. See the site plan below or on [google maps](#).
- Dog excrement is a health hazard, and any mess must be cleared up immediately.
- Dog waste (included bagged waste) must not be put in clubhouse bins. Bagged dog waste must be disposed in the designated dog waste bins.
- Dogs are allowed in the clubhouse on a short lead.
- Keep dogs away from food preparation and serving area.
- The club reserves the right to require a dog to be removed from the site.
- Managers and coaches must ensure that any visiting teams are aware of this policy.

Worcester RFC - Dog Free Zones



- No dogs on or between the pitches on Cummings
- ALL bagged dog poo to be placed in the dog waste bins.
- No dogs within the fenced area around pitch 1 & 2
- No dog poo in the bins by the clubhouse
- No dogs on the MJ pitches
- No dogs within the fenced area around pitch 3 and 4
